

Cortisol Stimulation

The Cortisol stimulation test is intended for use as a diagnostic agent in the screening of patients for adrenocortical insufficiency. A baseline cortisol is drawn, cosyntropin medication is administered, and the patient then has blood specimens drawn at 30 minutes and 60 minutes after the injection.

PROTOCOL

- 1. Register patient
- 2. Order the following tests:
 - Cosyntropin (Nursing Order)
 - ACTH Stimulation Test (LAB711)
- 3. Draw a **baseline** specimen no more than 30 minutes prior to administration of cosyntropin.
- 4. Administer cosyntropin according to instructions and note the time of injection.
- 5. Draw an additional specimen **30-minutes post** cosyntropin administration. Indicate time of draw on tube.
- 6. Draw an additional specimen **60-minute post** cosyntropin administration. Indicate time of draw on tube.
