## 24 HOUR URINE COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Obtain specimen container from outpatient services.
- 2. Collection may begin any time and will end 24 hours later (start and end times should match exactly).
- 3. Urinate and discard your first specimen into the toilet. Record this as your start time and date of the 24-hour collection. Every time AFTER this collect urine into the 24-hour collection jug.
- 4. During collection time, it is important to have adequate fluid intake.
- 5. Refrigerate urine during collection.

- 6. Keep saving the urine until the 24-hour period is done.
- 7. Label the container with patient name, date of birth, start date, start time, end date, end time, and physician.



8. Deliver the specimen to the laboratory promptly after the collection is complete:

Belgrade: Mon-Fri 7:30am-5pm, Sat 8am-5pm
Big Sky: Mon –Sun 8am-7pm

After hours/Weekends: Please go to the front registration desk at the Emergency Department. Please allow adequate time for staff to confirm your lab orders and accept your specimen.
